Launched in 2004 as one of the world's first film festivals to focus solely on films shot on digital in order to discover and nurture emerging talent, the 14th edition of SKIP CITY INTERNATIONAL D-Cinema FESTIVAL has been held from Saturday, July 15 to Sunday, July 23 for 9 days and wrapped at the Closing Ceremony, Sunday July 23.

The Audience Award for the three competition sections wasn't announced at the Closing Ceremony, and it is now revealed. This award was decided by not Juries but by the votes from the audience, and so the award winner is the most popular film from the audience.



The audience award winner for the Feature Length Competition is "3ft Ball & Souls" directed by Yoshio Kato. At the Closing Ceremony of July 23, it already received the SKIP CITY AWARD which is awarded to the most promising talent among the Japanese nominees for Feature Length Competition. It is only the film which won two awards at this year's festival.

Comment from Director Gori

I think the Aguni Island's custom endorsed me this award. I even didn't know about "senkotsu" before I made this film. It's a very mysterious custom that the people send their ancestors off with lots of love. The stories about "senkotsu" told by the grannies in the Island made the script lush and the volunteer support from the youth in the Island cheered the production team. The shooting schedule was really tight and I sometimes felt pressure. However, the crew members made the shooting pleasant and relieved my tense and the cast members really enjoyed the shooting, and so the shooting wrapped with great feeling. I'm very happy with receiving this award because the audience enjoyed my film with the team's passion and the history of the Aguni Island.

Admission number of SKIP CITY INTERNATIONAL D-Cinema FESTIVAL 2017

SKIP CITY INTERNATIONAL D-Cinema FESTIVAL 2017, which is the 14th edition, was held from Saturday, July 15 to Sunday, July 23 for 9 days. The total admission number of this year was 9,228. Meanwhile that of 2016 was 9,050. The number is the third highest after 10,043 of 2013 and 9,375 of 2015. Also, average number per day is 1,025 and is the second biggest next to that of 2015 (because the festival was held for 10 days in 2013).

We suppose the increase of the number happened because the festival itself is more widely recognized and attracted not only Saitama residents but also the audience who live outside Saitama, particularly Tokyo residents. We consider it is another reason that the quality of competitions is getting higher.
